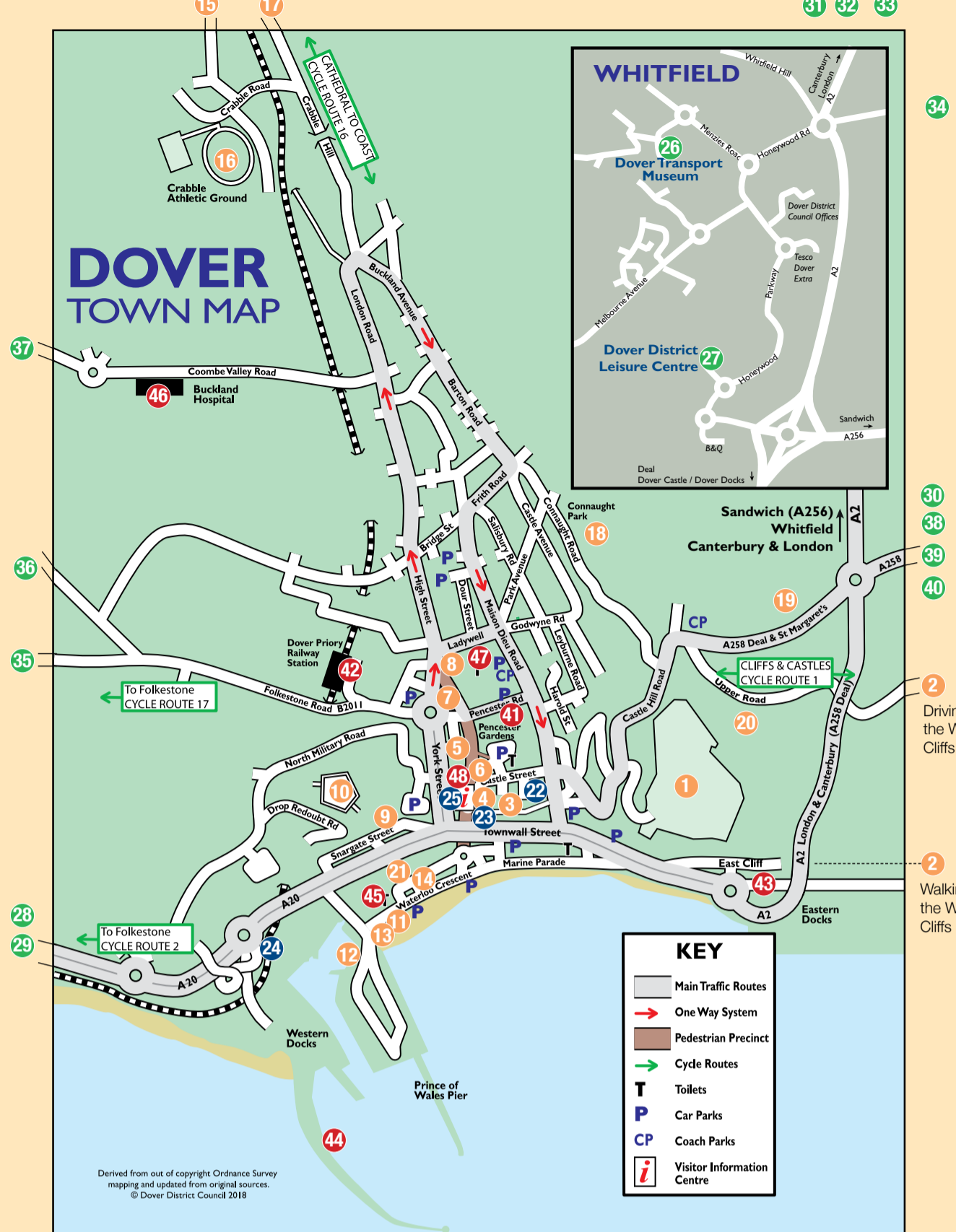
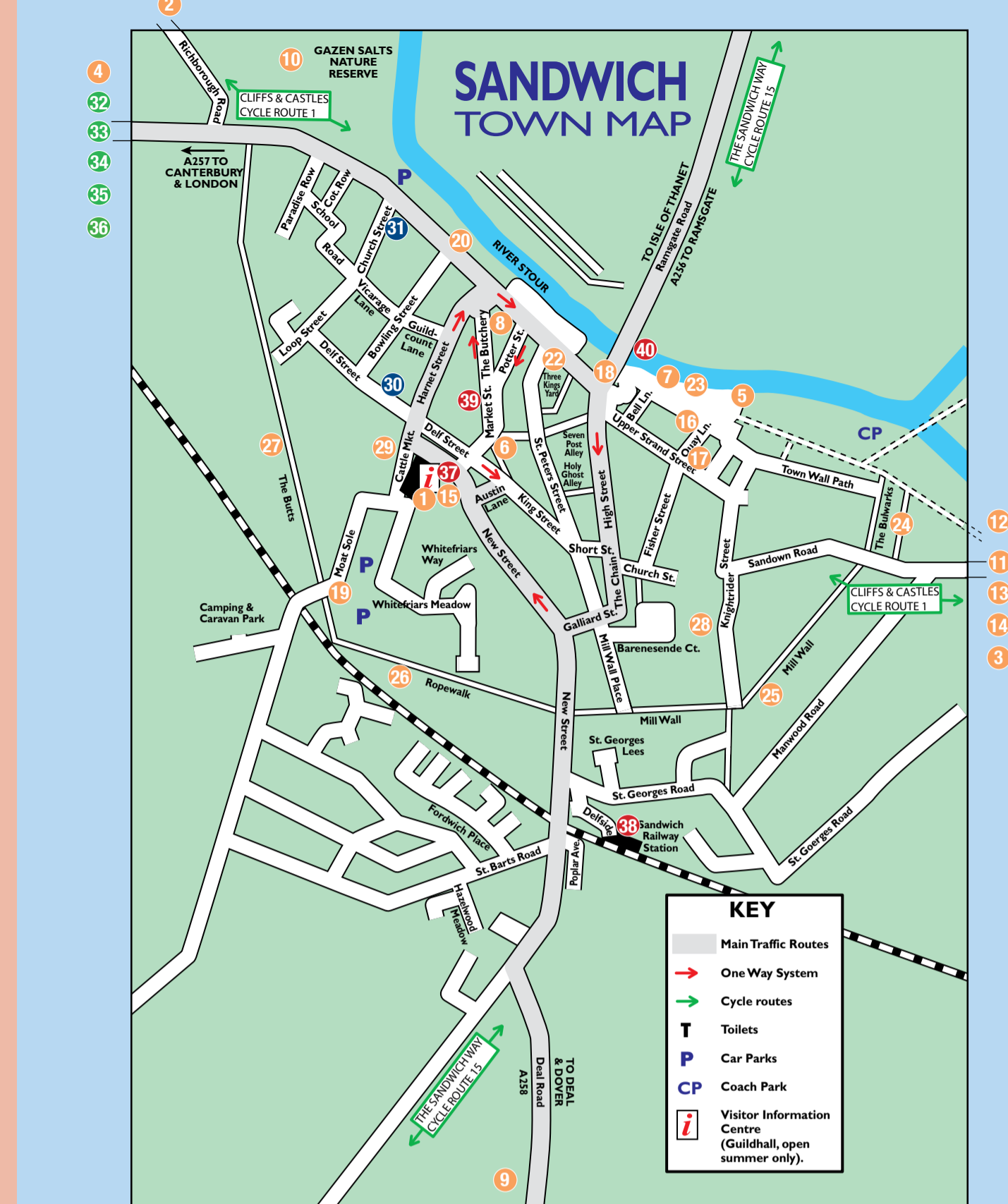

1 DOVER CASTLE
Discover 2000 years of history! Immerse yourself in the medieval world and royal court of King Henry II inside the Great Tower. Travel deep inside the White Cliffs and tour the Underground Hospital within the Secret Wartime Tunnels.
CT16 1HU

2 DEAL CASTLE
Built by the order of King Henry VIII, Deal Castle is one of the finest Tudor artillery castles in England. Come and explore the whole of the castle from the exciting dark passages to the first floor captain's residence.
CT14 7BA

3 WALMER CASTLE & GARDENS
Built in 1540 as part of Henry VIII's chain of coastal defences, the castle is now an elegant stately home and has been home to an incredible range of characters. See the original Wellington boots, the reception rooms of HM Queen Elizabeth the Queen Mother and explore the magnificent gardens.

4 RICHBOROUGH ROMAN FORT & AMPHITHEATRE
The impressive ruins of the Roman Township at Richborough mark the point from which the Romans launched their successful invasion of Britain in 43 AD. Extensive remains of the walls and defensive ditches can be seen.

5 THE WESTERN HEIGHTS, DROP REDoubT AND ST MARTIN'S BATTERY
The Western Heights are one of the most impressive and important fortifications in Britain. Explore and discover the historic fortress, battery and more during one of the Western Heights Open Weekends.

6 FORT BURGUYNE
Fort Burgoyne was built in the 1860s to protect Dover Castle. The main fort comprised of a large parade ground, and accommodation for soldiers and officers. Although there is no public access to the site, look out for one of the many 'Discover Fort Burgoyne' guided walks.

7 DOVER MUSEUM & BRONZE AGE BOAT GALLERY
Housing a range of fascinating objects, models and pictures showing the history of Dover including the Bronze Age Boat. Thought to be some 3000 years old the oldest known sea-going boat is now displayed just yards from where it was found in 1992.

8 BATTLE OF BRITAIN MEMORIAL
Situated high up on the White Cliffs at Capel-le-Ferne, the memorial is dedicated to Churchill's famous 'Fm' who fought in the skies overhead to keep their country free from invasion. Visit the iconic building 'The Wing' and see the high tech multimedia Scramble Experience which gives visitors an idea of life during the Battle.

9 DEAL MUSEUM
Learn about Deal's maritime history with special exhibitions, displays of real and model boats, local life and social history objects. The museum celebrates the history of the Royal Marines in Deal over 350 years with an exhibition including written information, photographs and artefacts.

10 SANDWICH GUILDHALL MUSEUM
The recently refurbished museum tells the story of Sandwich from the Mesolithic period to the modern day with an array of artefacts plus display of an original Magna Carta and Charter of the Forest. Also visitors will be able to explore the unique Tudor Court Room.

11 DOVER TRANSPORT MUSEUM
Set in nearly two acres of attractive grounds, with ample parking, the museum's two large galleries include over fifty road vehicles many arranged in period street scenes. From bicycles to buses, the vehicles include many which are unusual or unique.

12 TIMEBALL TOWER MUSEUM
Video, static and interactive displays cover 3 centuries of involvement in signalling the fight against smuggling and as a vital link in safe navigation of distant oceans.

13 KENT MUSEUM OF THE MOVING IMAGE
The museum centres on a collection of cinema and pre-cinema artefacts, with more than 50,000 items in its collection amassed over nearly sixty years.

14 LITTLE FARTHINGLOE FARM & THE WOMEN'S LAND ARMY MUSEUM
Fartlingloe is an historic site that was mentioned in the Domesday Book. The Women's Land Army Museum gives a fascinating insight into the life of women serving their country during the Second World War.

15 ELVINGTON & EYTHORNE HERITAGE CENTRE
Learn about the history of Tilmanstone Colliery and the mining villages at the Elvington and Eythorne Heritage Centre. The centre is packed with information including plans, images and memorabilia.

16 ROMAN PAINTED HOUSE
See detailed displays on Roman Dover at the Roman Painted House. This finest surviving Roman period house was built about AD 200 and formed part of a large mansio or official hotel for travellers crossing the English Channel.

17 SOUTH FORELAND LIGHTHOUSE
A striking Victorian landmark on the White Cliffs of Dover, this fascinating historic building was the first to display an electronically powered signal. Take a guided tour of the lighthouse and learn all about its historical connectors.

18 DEAL PIER
Deal's present pier was built in 1954 and was the first seaside pleasure pier of any size to be built since 1910. The pier has international recognition as an angling venue. Visit the new Deal Pier Kitchen in the award-winning building at the end of the pier.

19 WHITE MILL RURAL HERITAGE CENTRE
Built in 1760, this restored Smock Mill has original wooden machinery, millers cottage and domestic rural displays.
CT13 9JB

20 CRABBLE CORN MILL
Restored in 1986, this Georgian watermill is classed as the finest working mill in Europe. Built in 1812 to supply flour to troops defending the Kent Coast from possible invasion from Napoleon's forces, the mill is packed with history.
CT17 0UY

21 THE GRAND SHAFT
Built during the Napoleonic Wars to link the Harbour to the barracks on the Western Heights. A unique triple staircase, winding round a central light-well, dropping 140 feet through the cliffs.

22 CHILLENDEN MILL
This grade II listed building is a distinctive local landmark. The renovated smock mill stands on a hill at Chillenden, with fine countryside views.
CT3 10E

23 DEAL MEMORIAL BANDSTAND
The Deal Memorial Bandstand is seen as a 'living' Royal Marines Memorial to those who died. It is located on Walmer Green in Deal and is a memorial to the 11 musicians killed when the Royal Marines barracks was bombed on 22nd September 1989. Concerts are held regularly.

24 BLERIOT MEMORIAL
On 25 July 1909, Louis Bleriot was the first person to fly across the English Channel. The light took only 37 minutes. A memorial in the form of a stone silhouette of Bleriot's plane is set into the ground at the place where he landed.

25 WHITE CLIFFS OF DOVER
One of this country's most spectacular natural features, enjoy an exhilarating cliff top walk offering unrivalled views of the busy English Channel. National Trust shop and cafe.

26 FAIN BAY
Take a journey into the past on a guided tour of Fain Bay Deep Shelter in the White Cliffs of Dover. Follow your guide deep into the cliffs where the 125 steps take you in and out of the shelter 70 feet underground.

27 SAMPHIRE HOE
Get up close to nature with a visit to Samphire Hoe. The site made from the material dug to create the Channel Tunnel is a stunning location providing gentle and interesting walks - the further you get from the car park the more wild the site becomes.

28 ST MARGARET'S BAY
Take a paddle in the sea, indulge in a delicious cream tea or enjoy a cliff top walk with breathtaking coastal views. St Margaret's Bay is a fantastic place for rock pooling - a great way to discover the wildlife that exists along the coast.

29 BETTESHANGER PARK
Wonderful 250-acre Country Park providing activities such as walking, cycling, fossicking, archery, and geocaching plus an abundance of wildlife to see over crowded even on the hottest days. It is a private estate with a toll charge but worth the cost.

30 SANDWICH BAY
Sandwich is a wonderful beach, perfect for quiet relaxation. Dog friendly and with a Nature Reserve a short walk along the dunes. The sea is always warm and the beach is never over crowded even on the hottest days. It is a private estate with a toll charge but worth the cost.

31 GOODNESTONE PARK GARDENS
Beautiful and peaceful gardens considered to be one of the best in the South East covering approximately 14 acres including woodland area and walled garden. Fine trees, large collection of roses and herbaceous plants. Connections with Jane Austen who frequently visited.

32 KEARSNEY PARKS (KEARSNEY ABBEY & RUSSELL GARDENS)
Once part of grand country houses and estates, they now are beautiful open spaces for the public to enjoy. The River Dour flows through the parks, and the ornamental lakes are ideal for swans, moonchairs, ducks and other wildlife.

33 THE PINES CALYX, GARDEN & MUSEUM
Set behind the White Cliffs, this 6 acre site includes a grass labyrinth and sensory garden. Opposite the gardens is St Margaret's Museum featuring displays on local history including former resident Noel Coward.

34 SANDWICH BAY BIRD OBSERVATORY
SBBOT is an independent conservation charity that works to maintain the local environment and to monitor the changes in bird, butterfly, dragonfly and all other species in the area. The site has a modern field centre with accommodation.

35 WESTERN HEIGHTS (LOCAL NATURE RESERVE)
This 'Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty' surrounds the extensive historic Western Heights fortifications. Discover the history, wildflowers and wildlife of the chalk downland on three waymarked walking routes.
CT17 9D0

36 WHINLESS DOWN (LOCAL NATURE RESERVE)
This Local Nature Reserve is a gateway to the Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty. A good place to see the wildflowers and butterflies of ancient chalk grassland.
